Service Hours reduced

The service hour requirement for renewal is reduced to 4 hours per year. This should make it so much easier for nearly everyone to get their hours and not have to pay the \$100 surcharge. Only those over 70, disabled, or who live out of state are exempt. If you are exempt, you just indicate that on the same form as if you were reporting hours.

Three ways to renew

Fill out the forms and mail to our PO Box along with a check.
Fill out the forms and bring them to a meeting, and use a check, cash, or a credit or debit card.
Renew online: Fill out the form online, pay with credit card.
Online renewals are \$200 without the 4 service hours requirement. With the service hours met, its only the original \$100. If over 70 or physically unable to get the hours, you can indicate that on the hours form to be exempt from that requirement.
Life members pay \$20.

North Whidbey Sportsmen's Association Membership Form



The NORTH WHIDBEY SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION is open to all persons eighteen years of age & older who are legally able to own a firearm. Membership privileges begin upon receipt of membership card and are valid for 12 months from that date. A renewal/update is due annually. Late renewals may require the member to rejoin as a new member.



NOTE: ALL Members are required to submit this form each year in order to retain your status.

I agree to comply with the BYLAWS and to support the objectives of the Association. I am expected to participate in club activities and to serve on at least one committee. When using Association facilities, I must display proof of membership at all times. I am fully aware and understand that I am responsible for my actions and the actions of my guests.

4 hours service to NWSA is required per year of membership. Failure to perform 4 hours service results in an additional \$100 added to the membership renewal fee. Service may be anything that contributes to the betterment or operations of the club. If it's a service to NWSA and requires the member's time, it qualifies. Examples are:

- Labor—including working on buildings, mowing, grounds improvement, brush/undergrowth control, road maintenance, range maintenance, equipment maintenance.
- Administrative functions, including managing guest waivers, managing the AED maintenance, assisting with any NWSA Administration duty.
- Working parties, RSO duties, Instructor duties, Match directors, and Kitchen Crew.
- Anything that directly contributes to the benefit of NWSA.
